Solidarity and Sustainable development: our common challenge.

Supporting the capacity of institutional, political and faith-based community actors hosting the influx of 1.5 million Syrian refugees and working for social peace, is a current challenge shared by the countries concerned and the international community as a whole.

Lebanon has hosted the largest number of Syrian refugees in the world and its population has increased by 20% in 8 years. The capacity of Lebanon is exceeded.

The economic, health and social problems posed acutely by newcomers which half of whom are children, lead to community-based humanitarian action in the neighborhood and educational, training, integration and resettlement support.

Collaboration and Presence in Lebanon and Syria

Driven from their homeland, these Syrian families came to Lebanon in very difficult conditions. They feel vulnerable. But they are strong men, women, young people and children .

NEW VISION and its partners help them overcome the trauma and find the resources to rebuild their lives.

What they need is a center like NEW VISION educational center so they can come and find strength.

Extent of work

A solidarity service that reaches refugees in their most basic needs, reinforcing and facilitating their rehabilitation and social cohesion.

NEW VISION maintains the link and psycho-social rehabilitation through the creation of regional branches on both sides of the Lebanese-Syrian border.

For example, NEW VISION is committed to:

Reach the most vulnerable children and families in need of support, including those with severe emotional trauma, high risk of violence and living in extreme poverty through humanitarian and development assistance.

Provide a safe space and educational activities for children and young people in very precarious situations.

Strengthen the capacities of young people and women through qualifying activities and sensitization campaigns on specific themes related to hygiene and health.

Participate in the resettlement of refugee families in their country of origin.



Impact in Lebanon: example of educational activities

Basic education is a humanitarian human right, just like water, sanitation, food, security and housing. Education is recognized as offering psychological, physical and cognitive protection essential in emergency situations. Traumatized by eight years of humanitarian crisis, the children of the Syrian revolution are often out of school and forced to work or get married.

By offering a safe space and psycho-educational follow-up to some fifty refugee children, NEW VISION is investing in the present and the future of a generation of children and their families affected by the crisis in Syria.

Our programs



Educational Center

NON DISCRIMINATION & ADAPTED LEARNING

In addition to the school education provided in Arabic and English to about fifty refugee children, a nutritional meal is served daily and hygiene training is given.

The focus is on tolerance, friendship and the recognition of a healthy environment.



Awareness campaigns

HYGIENE & HEALTH

Teams of doctors and medical staff sensitize women and girls about the importance of good hygiene and nutrition practices for their families, the prevention of diseases and the improvement of their immunity.



Empowerment of women

STRENGTHENING BASIC & PROFESSIONAL SKILLS

Providing psychosocial support and life skills and vocational training to Syrian women to help them overcome the trauma and find the resources to rebuild their lives.

Women help each other to find solutions to their common challenges.



Repatriation projects and social cohesion

RECONSTRUCTION & REHABILITATION

Helping 48 Syrian families over two years to resettle in their home country.

Meeting the current challenges

Integrate human rights and sustainable development into social, economic, cultural and environmental policies and quality of daily life.

NEW VISION helps to find long-term solutions for refugees, ensuring that displaced generations are equipped to rebuild their lives and communities - either in Lebanon as a country of asylum or by returning to their country in Syria.

NEW VISION works with its partners to achieve, among other things, the right to quality education for displaced children, in line with Sustainable Development Goal 4. and contributes to bridging the gap in educational needs.

The interventions of NEW VISION allow a reduction of the risks inherent to the non-schooling, the malnutrition, the lack of hygiene and psychological and social support but also the work of the children and the early marriage, while improving the dialogue social, the quality of life on a daily basis and resettlement in the country of origin.

NEW VISION thus remains at the service of the region's strategy, social, economic and environmental performance by being a partner of ongoing programs.
